#### SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS & AWARD INFORMATION:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior in the application year.
- Applicant must be attending a 2 to 4 year college or university or a trade school in the fall of the application year.
- Applicant must fully complete the Scholarship Application and answer the essay prompts as noted.
- Scholarship checks will be issued to the college, university or trade school the Applicant is enrolled in for fall of the application year.
- Scholarship must be claimed (or a one time, one year extension request received) by August 1, 2024
- VCHS scholarship recipient(s) will be recognized at the VCHS Senior Awards night.
- Scholarship recipient(s) from other high schools may request recognition at their Senior Awards night and VC Stampede will make every effort to attend and present the scholarship.
- Scholarships will be awarded by the Board of Directors of the Valley Center Stampede Rodeo & Memorial Festival. The following criteria will be reviewed and weighted in the Board's consideration of award. All awards are at the sole discretion of the Board.
